.....Administration. Borough Manager - The daily operations of the Borough are administered by the borough manager. The manager is responsible for the daily administration of the Borough under the direction of Borough Council. The manager oversees all employees of the borough which includes Administration, Public Works and Pitcairn Power. ([Click Here](#)). Staff & Office Hours .Administrative Staff - Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Payment for electric can be made from 8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m., Monday - Friday. We are located at 582 Sixth Street at Highland. From Broadway, travel up Center Avenue to Highland. Turn right on Highland to the stop sign at Sixth Street. The municipal building is on your right. Pitcairn Police Department .The Pitcairn Police Department is under the direction of newly appointed Chief Scott Farally. Street Department .The four-man street department is responsible for the physical condition of the Borough. This includes maintenance of the roads, public parks, storm sewers and all Borough owned property. ([Click Here](#)). Real Estate Tax Collector. Local & School Real Estate Tax is collected by Sally DiRobbio, an elected tax collector. Borough of Pitcairn taxes are mailed June 1. Everyone who owns property within the Borough of Pitcairn should receive a real estate tax bill. If you do not receive a tax bill, contact the office at the number below. .Payments can be made by mail, in person or through the drop off slot near her front door.
