

BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN  
ORDINANCE NO. 1030

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ADMINISTRATION AND GOVERNMENT, OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN CODE, SPECIFICALLY PART 8, SECTIONS 801, 802, 803 AND 804, AS TO THE RECOGNITION OF THE PITCAIRN HOSE COMPANY #1 AS THE SOLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OF THE BOROUGH, AND REMOVING THE PITCAIRN RELIEF FIRE COMPANY NUMBER 2 AS A RECOGNIZED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OF THE BOROUGH.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Borough of Pitcairn, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that Chapter 1, Administration and Government of the Borough of Pitcairn Code, specifically Part 8, Recognizing Volunteer Fire Companies, shall be amended as follows:

1. That Chapter 1, Part 8, Section 801, Recognition, shall be amended to read as follows: "The Borough of Pitcairn hereby recognizes the Pitcairn Hose Company #1 as the sole volunteer fire company which has been organized by the residents of said Borough. No other organization dedicated to the fighting of fires is authorized to operate within the Borough except for those acting under a mutual aid or other agreement approved by Borough Council".
2. That Chapter 1, Part 8, Section 802, Authority, shall be amended to read as follows: "The Pitcairn Hose Company #1 is hereby give all power, so far as the Borough of Pitcairn has power to grant the same, to enact such rules and regulations for the management and government off individual members thereof as shall be necessary for the proper maintenance and control of said Volunteer Fire Company. Neither the grant of the aforesaid power nor the recognition set forth in Section 1-801 above shall be construed as constituting the Pitcairn Hose Company #1 as an agent, department, or employees of the Borough except insofar as such effect is provided under the provisions of the Act of June 2 1915, P.L. 736, No. 338, known as the "Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act", 77 P.S. Section 101, et seq., or the Act of November 26, 1978, P.L. 1399, No. 330, known as the "Political Subdivision Tort Claims Act", 42 Pa. C.S.A. Section 8541, et. seq."


3. That Chapter 1, Part 8, Section 803, Officers, shall be amended to read as follows: "The members of Pitcairn Hose Company #1 may elect from their numbers such officers as may be provided by the bylaws of the Fire Company."
4. That Chapter 1, Part 8, Section 804, Control of Equipment and Funds, shall be amended to read as follows: "All appropriations made by the Borough of Pitcairn to or for the use of said Fire Company, whether of money or property, and all equipment purchased by the Borough for said Fire Company shall continue to be the property of the Borough. None of the fire apparatus or equipment so belonging to the Borough shall be permanently removed from the Borough without thereof."
5. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such holding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.
6. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon the date of execution.




