

**BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN**

**ORDINANCE NO. 985**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 917 AS AMENDED AND FIXING THE SALARIES AND RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE APPOINTIVE OFFICERS, AND MONTHLY AND HOURLY EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA BEGINNING JANUARY 2012.**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has, by Ordinance No. 917 set the salaries and/or fees of its appointed and salaried positions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has, from time to time amended Ordinance 917 to update said salaries and/or fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough desires to again amend the said Ordinance and update same to set salaries and fees to begin in January 2012.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn, Allegheny County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted that Ordinance No. 917, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The salaries of the appointive officers of the Borough of Pitcairn shall be fixed as follows:

Borough Treasurer	To serve without pay
Borough Secretary	To serve without pay
Borough Solicitor	\$30,000.00 annually plus costs
Borough Engineer	\$90.00 hourly rate

SECTION 2. The salaries of the monthly full time employees of the Borough of Pitcairn Police Department (excluding the Chief of Police), shall be as agreed to in the police labor agreement which shall take precedence over this ordinance.

SECTION 3: Exempt monthly employees shall be as follows, per FLSA CFR 541.1:

Borough Manager	\$ 4,410.00
Chief of Police	\$ 4,371.67.

SECTION 4: The hourly rate of monthly employees not listed above are as follows:

Finance & Utility Clerk	\$ 16.47 per hr.
-------------------------	------------------

Office Clerk	\$ 13.36 per hr.
Front Window Office Clerk	\$ 11.30 per hr.

SECTION 5. Hourly employee's wages for public works shall receive wages pursuant to the following schedule:

Current wage:	
Working Foreman	\$ 20.11 per hr.
Working Utility Foreman	\$ 25.00 per hr.
Electrical Engineer	\$ 20.60 per hr.
Cable & Internet Engineer	\$ 19.52 per hr.
Laborer I	\$ 17.39 per hr.
Laborer II	\$ 15.86 per hr.
Laborer III	\$ 14.50 per hr.

SECTION 6. The wage of hourly part time employees shall be fixed as follows:

- (a). Extra and part time casual police patrolman shall receive the following pay beginning January 2012:

Patrolman	\$ 12.25 per hr.
Class II	\$ 13.25 per hr.
Class III	\$ 14.25 per hr.

Note that this increase does not apply to full time officers covered under a separate labor agreement as set forth in Section 2, above.

- (b). School Crossing Guards: \$31.00 per day.

Extra and special patrolmen will work in the classification determined by the Council upon motion. To be eligible for Class II an extra patrolman must have in excess of one thousand five hundred hours of police experience with Pitcairn Borough. To be eligible for Class III an extra patrolman must have in excess of three thousand hours of police experience with Pitcairn Borough.

New hire patrolmen will receive an initial \$200.00 uniform allowance after completion of six (6) months of service. Extra and special patrolmen who work more than fifty (50) eight (8) hour shifts in a previous calendar year are entitled to a clothing allowance of \$225.00 and any working twenty five (25) to forty nine (49) eight (8) hour shifts in a previous calendar year are entitled to a clothing allowance of \$115.00. Anyone working less than twenty five (25) eight (8) hour shifts in a previous year will not receive a clothing allowance.

SECTION 7. For employees of all departments, who qualify for overtime payment, overtime shall be calculated at the rate of one and one-half times their normal rate of pay

after eight (8) hours work in any one day, or only after forty (40) hours work in any one work week.


SECTION 8. The salaries and wages set forth in this Ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2012.

SECTION 9. That any ordinance or parts of an Ordinance, or any prior Resolution or parts of a Resolution, conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.


SECTION 10. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

**ORDAINED AND ENACTED** this 29<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011.




