ORDINANCE NO. 989

AN ORDINANCE OF BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA OFFERING A RETIREMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR ALL ACTIVE AND ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pitcairn hereby establishes a retirement incentive program for all active and eligible employees; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has required all active and eligible employees who intend to retire and use the retirement incentive program to make a written choice to the Borough of Pitcairn within ninety (90) days from the passage of this Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn, County of Allegheny, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Borough of Pitcairn hereby establishes a retirement window that will allow all active and eligible employees who are at least 55 years old and have at least 10 years of service to retire and receive their accrued benefit payable immediately and without reduction for early commencement.

SECTION 2: All active and eligible employees shall elect to make this selection within 90 days from the passage of the within Ordinance.

SECTION 3: There shall be a benefit multiplier of 1.5% for those retiring in this window. The compensation paid to the retiree will be based upon the W-2 pay.

SECTION 4: In addition, any active and eligible employee who elects to retire during this window shall receive single person medical benefits not to exceed \$500.00 per month until such time as the employee is Medicare eligible or 65 years of age, whichever is earlier.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance ratifies the Resolution passed on November 13, 2012 authorizing the Retirement incentive program.

SECTION 6: SEVERABILITY.




SECTION 7: REPEALER.


