ORDINANCE NO. 1002 of 2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A MONTHLY FIVE-DOLLAR SERVICE FEE ON EVERY ELECTRIC CONSUMER IN THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN TO BE USED FOR PUBLIC SAFETY APPROPRIATIONS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE, RESCUE SERVICE AND AMBULANCE SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Code at 53 P.S. § 46202 sets forth specific powers of Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, 53 P.S. § 46202(5) authorizes Council to make such regulations as may be necessary for the health, safety, morals, general welfare and cleanliness and the beauty, convenience, comfort and safety of the borough; and

WHEREAS, 53 P.S. § 46202(35) further authorizes Council to purchase, or contribute to the purchase of fire engines and fire apparatus, boats, rescue and life saving equipment and supplies for the use of the borough for fire, rescue and life saving services including community ambulance service and to appropriate money for fire companies and rescue units located within the borough; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the general and specific powers enumerated in the Borough Code, Council for the Borough of Pitcairn is desirous of implementing a monthly \$5.00 service fee to be added to the bill for each electric consumer in the Borough of Pitcairn to be used for public safety purposes, including but not limited to fire protection, rescue and ambulance services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pitcairn, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, at a duly convened meeting, quorum present as follows:

SECTION 1: SERVICE FEE ESTABLISHED. The Borough of Pitcairn hereby establishes a monthly service fee of \$5.00 per month, which shall be added as an additional charge to the monthly electric bills for all electric consumers in the Borough of Pitcairn.

SECTION 2: PLACEMENT INTO SEPARATE FUND; DISCRETION OF COUNCIL: Money received from this service fee will be placed into a separate public safety fund, which shall be managed by the Borough of Pitcairn, and used or appropriated only for public safety causes, including but not limited to matters related to fire protection services, rescue services and ambulance services. It shall be Council's decision, in its sole discretion, how

much, if any of money received from this public service fee shall be used or appropriated for any particular public service issue of cause.


SECTION 3: REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn that the several provisions of this Ordinance are separable. If any Court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any words, sentences, sections or provisions of this Ordinance to be invalid, such a ruling shall not affect any other words, sentences, sections or provisions of this Ordinance not specifically included in said ruling.


SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval in accordance with the Borough Code.




