ORDINANCE NO. 1005

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING
THE REDUCTION OF SERVICE YEARS NECESSARY FOR
VESTING OF THE NON-UNIFORM PENSION PLAN.**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pitcairn has established a non-uniform pension plan in accordance with the CBA and the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, it presently takes fifteen (15) years of service for before the pension vests; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pitcairn desires to reduce the vesting requirement from fifteen (15) years to ten (10) years of services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pitcairn has had the appropriate actuarial study performed which established that the change would not immediately affect the actuarial status of the plan; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn, County of Allegheny, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: REDUCTION OF VESTING PERIOD. The Borough of Pitcairn hereby reduces the vesting requirement for the non-uniform employee pension plan from fifteen (15) years to ten (10) years of services.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance in its entirety or any part thereof, other than that so

declared invalid.

SECTION 3: REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.

ENACTED AND ADOPTED by the Council this 10 day of November, 2014.




