ORDINANCE NO. 986

AN ORDINANCE OF BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 978 CHAPTER 15 SECTION 207 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN AND DESIGNATING HIGH STREET AS ONE WAY BEGINNING SOUTH AT THE INTERSECTION OF NINTH STREET AND CREIGHTON AVENUE AND ENDING EAST AT HIGHLAND AVENUE AND NINTH STREET. IN THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pitcairn is a municipal entity organized pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania including but not limited to the Pennsylvania Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Code permits the Borough of Pitcairn to regulate the traffic patterns within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn that there is a traffic flow and parking problem along High Street from Ninth St. and Creighton Ave. to Highland Ave. and Ninth St; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Pitcairn has determined that it is in the best interests of the residents of the Borough of Pitcairn to dedicate that a portion of High Street to be a one-way street; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Pitcairn hereby declares that the Code and Ordinances of the Borough of Pitcairn shall be amended to make High Street one-way between Brinton and McGinnis Avenues; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Borough of Pitcairn hereby declares that this Ordinance is necessary for the protection and promotion of the health, welfare and safety of the Borough of Pitcairn and its residents and guests:

BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn, County of Allegheny, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and in accordance with the authority granted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including but not limited to the provisions of 53 P.S. §46202, and 53 P.S. §46007, as well as the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S. §6109, as follows:

SECTION 1. AMENDING CODE TO MAKE HIGH STREET ONE WAY

The Council of the Borough of Pitcairn hereby amends Ordinance 907, Chapter 15, Section 207 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Pitcairn titled "one-way highways established" to include the following as a one way street within the Borough of Pitcairn and hereby directs the proper borough employees to place appropriate signage on the street accordingly:

<u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>	<u>DIRECTION OF TRAVEL PERMITTED</u>
High Street	Ninth St. and Creighton Ave.	Highland Ave. and Ninth St.	South to East

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance in its entirety or any part thereof, other than that so declared invalid.

SECTION 3: ENFORCEMENT.

Enforcement of this Ordinance shall be supplemental to enforcement under the Pennsylvania Crimes Code Section 7511. (18 Pa. C.S.A. § 7511 (1998)).

SECTION 4: REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of its adoption and advertisement.


