ORDINANCE NO. 990

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 713 OF
1973 AS CODIFIED IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF
THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN AT SECTION 22-101 *ET*.
SEQ. PERTAINING TO ELECTRIC POWER SERVICE**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 713 of 1973, as codified in the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Pitcairn sets forth various rules and procedures regarding Pitcairn's providing of Electric Power service to its ratepayers, and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance contains certain provisions that the Borough has ceased utilizing over the years and the Ordinance requires updating to reflect current practice; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Pitcairn of Allegheny County, as follows:

SECTION I: MODIFICATIONS TO CODIFIED ORDINANCE § 22-103

1. §22-103. B & C are deleted in their entirety.
2. §22-103. B is hereby amended to read: Ratepayers who are delinquent may cure the delinquency by entering into a delinquent ratepayer agreement attached to this Ordinance or as Council may from time to time amend by resolution.
3. §22-103 D & E shall now be deemed to be §22-103 C & D respectively.

SECTION II: INCORPORATION/REPEALER

3. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 846, and any amendments thereto are hereby affirmed and incorporated herein by reference and shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that they are not inconsistent herewith.
4. Any ordinance, or part thereof, conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same conflicts with this Ordinance.
5. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity

shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections of parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.


6. This Ordinance shall become effective in five (5) days after the adoption hereof.


