ORDINANCE 996 OF 2013

AN ORDINANCE OF BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE PITCAIRN SOLID WASTE ORDINANCE 856, TO PROVIDE FOR THE STANDARDS AND REGULATION FOR COLLECTION, SECTION V. SUBSECON 1, TO OMIT LESS THAN FOUR UNITS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 856, dealing with solid waste management, contains a provision at Section V., Subsection (1) requiring that Pitcairn shall provide for the collection of all garbage, rubbish and bulky wastes from individual residences and multi-family residential sources with less than four units, or it may contract with a private collector or collectors to provide this essential residential collection service; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is desirous of amending this Ordinance and section by deleting the words "with less than for units" such that collection of garbage will apply to all individual residences and multi-family residential sources regardless of the number of units therein; and

BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn, County of Allegheny, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 856, Section 5, Subsection 1 is hereby amended to remove the words "with less than four" and shall hereafter read as follows:

SECTION V: STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS FOR COLLECTION

1. The Municipality shall provide for the collection of all garbage, rubbish, bulky wastes from individual residences and multifamily residential sources, or it may contract with a private collector to provide this essential residential collection service.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.




SECTION 3: REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.




