

BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN

ORDINANCE NO. 999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 917 AS AMENDED AND FIXING THE SALARIES AND RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE APPOINTIVE OFFICERS, AND MONTHLY AND HOURLY EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF PITCAIRN, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA BEGINNING JANUARY 2014.

WHEREAS, the Borough has, by Ordinance No. 917 set the salaries and/or fees of its appointed and salaried positions; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has, from time to time amended Ordinance 917 to update said salaries and/or fees; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to again amend the said Ordinance and update same to set salaries and fees to begin in January 2014.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Council of the Borough of Pitcairn, Allegheny County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted that Ordinance No. 917, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The salaries of the appointive officers of the Borough of Pitcairn shall be fixed as follows:

Borough Treasurer	To serve without pay
Borough Secretary	To serve without pay
Borough Solicitor	\$30,000.00 annually plus costs
Borough Engineer	\$90.00 hourly rate

SECTION 2. The salaries of the monthly full time employees of the Borough of Pitcairn Police Department (excluding the Chief of Police), shall be as agreed to in the police labor agreement which shall take precedence over this ordinance.

SECTION 3: Exempt monthly employees shall be as follows, per FLSA CFR 541.1:

Borough Manager	\$ 4,506.67
Chief of Police	\$ 4,625.00

SECTION 4: The hourly rate of monthly employees not listed above are as follows:

Finance & Utility Clerk	\$ 14.17 per hr.
-------------------------	------------------

Office Clerk	\$ 14.17 per hr.
Front window office clerk	\$ 10.30 per hr
Ordinance Officer	\$ 16.35 per hr.
Occupancy Officer	\$13.00 per hr.

SECTION 5. Hourly employee's wages for public works shall receive wages pursuant to the following schedule: *Subject to change with pending collective bargaining agreement contract in 2014.*

Current wage:	
Working Foreman	\$ 26.00 per hr.
Working Utility Foreman	\$ per hr.
Electrical Engineer	\$ 21.60 per hr.
Cable & Internet Engineer	\$ 20.52 per hr.
Laborer I	\$ 18.39 per hr.
Laborer II	\$ 16.86 per hr.
Laborer III	\$ 15.50 per hr.

SECTION 6. The wage of hourly part time employees shall be fixed as follows:

- (a). Extra and part time casual police patrolman shall receive the following pay beginning January 2014: According to current contract, expiring December 31, 2013. (Subject to change with new contract)

Patrolman 4 years service	\$25.12 per hr.
Patrolman 3 years service	\$23.86 per hr.
Patrolman 2 years service	\$22.61 per hr.
Patrolman 1 year service	\$21.35 per hr.

Part Time 1	\$14.65
Part Time 2	\$12.65

- (b). School Crossing Guards: \$31.00 per day.

Extra and special patrolmen will work in the classification determined by the Council upon motion.

Part time patrolmen will receive \$100.00 uniform allowance after completion of four hundred, (400) hours of service in a current year. All part time officers will receive after nine (900) hundred hours of service in a current year \$200.00 for uniform allowance..

SECTION 7. For employees of all departments, who qualify for overtime payment, overtime shall be calculated at the rate of one and one-half times their normal rate of pay

after eight (8) hours work in any one day, or only after forty (40) hours work in any one work week.


SECTION 8. The salaries and wages set forth in this Ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2014.

SECTION 9. That any ordinance or parts of an Ordinance, or any prior Resolution or parts of a Resolution, conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.



It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED this 19th day of December, 2014.




