Pitcairn Borough Electric Contract Agreement

The Consumer agrees to pay the electric bill monthly as it becomes due, and at the schedule of rates as set-up by the Borough Council, failure to make such payments will warrant cause for the Shut-off of the supply of electricity.

The Borough agrees to install a watt-hour meter at a location on the premises to be determined by the Borough and it is agreed that the reading of this meter shall be conclusive for the determining of the amount of kilowatts used by the consumer and from which the monthly bills will be calculated.

If the Consumer is a renter then the Consumer is required to deposit the sum of One Fifty dollars (\$150.00) at the time of executing the contract, and this deposit will be retained by the Borough as security during the life of the contract, or until a time when all bills charged against the Consumer are paid in full. **Failure to make the meter deposit within 2 weeks of the execution of this contract will result in the SHUT OFF of the supply of electric to your residence.**

If the Consumer is a commercial account, the cash deposit will be increased to an amount of a comparable monthly electric bill.

The Consumer authorizes the Borough to set up its meter for the purpose of the aforesaid and grants its employees or agents access to the same at any reasonable hour for the purpose of reading, inspection, maintenance or removal of its property.

This Contract shall be and continue in effect for the time the Consumer resides at the service address. The Consumer agrees to notify the borough when the Consumer moves out of the service address, and Consumer will provide a forwarding address for the final bill.

In signing this contract, rental customers understand their landlord is furnished a duplicate bill due to enforcement of Borough Ordinances 982 and 1001.
